The **Family Services Employee Assistance Program**, otherwise known as the <u>FSEAP</u>, is a confidential benefit available to all permanent CUPE 411 members as part of the Employers (SD#33) agreement with the CTA (Chilliwack Teachers Association). The Union has been assured that members accessing available programs will not have their names or the nature of the discussions disclosed to the Employer. Only members who are casual, or who are requesting access to additional program sessions will be required to seek permission from the Employer to do so and at that point the Employer is then made aware of the names of the employees and the specific services they are accessing.



How to access information:

Step 1 – Click on the link above and it will direct you to the Home page.



Step 2 – Click on the **Login** icon.



Step 3 – Type the name "chilliwack" in the field labeled "Enter Group or Username" and then click Search.






Step 4 - Our District name "School District #33 (Chilliwack) will populate below, click on it.



Step 5 – You will be redirected to a Login screen, in the field titled Password, type in "2bwell" and then click Login.



Step 6 – You will now have access to information available to employees of SD#33. If you need to view the details in French this is an option (see top of the page) and the three stacked straigh lines is the Menu icon. Scrolling down the home page will provide you access to Quick Links, Your Program Supports, Self-Help, Frequently Asked Questions, and details on Confidentiality.



The Union is working on providing an opportunity for members to access additional services such as Professional Short-term Counselling and Critical Incident/Trauma Response so that if permanent members who need additional sessions will not be required to make such requests directly to the Employer. We also are looking into options for Casual Members to gain access to these services as well that will allow for anonymity.

Permanent members are reminded that the changes to our extended health plan now provides a \$1,500/year benefit for Clinical Counsellors & Social Workers, and Psychologist appointments, that will come into effect July 1, 2023.
