The Union has made arrangements with a local, licensed, childcare provider to open up their registration to our members who require childcare from **7:30am – 3:30pm**, in order to attend Pro-D sessions on **February 22, 2019**.

Members who are interested are asked to email Tanya at <u>littlemountainchildcarecenter@gmail.com</u> for a registration package and all childminding will take place at **McCammon Elementary**.

Members will be able to submit their applications from February 4 - 20. There are a limited number of spaces available (30) for school aged children, Kindergarten – Grade 6, with a few spots (4) for children ages 3 - 5, so please do not delay.

The Union will be covering this cost for its members, and in light of that fact we will require members to email the confirmation of their session's registration to <a href="mailto:unionoffice@cupe411.ca">unionoffice@cupe411.ca</a>. You will also be required to sign in when dropping off your child(ren) and sign out when you pick them up.

Through the registration process the provider will discuss any questions or concerns you might have as well as address any emergency information (i.e. medical alerts) with you. You will also receive a schedule of events for the day and who the staff are that will be caring for your child(ren). Parents will be asked to pack a light snack or lunch and any other necessities that their child(ren) might require.
