June 30th 2019 brings an end to our existing Collective Agreement with the Chilliwack School District. The CUPE 411 Negotiating Committee has proposed dates to start scheduling bargaining meetings with our Employer.

With Provincial bargaining already completed, your CUPE 411 Negotiating Committee has been meeting in preparation for representing our needs at the Local level. Currently our CUPE 411 Negotiating Committee is finalizing our strategic plan and bargaining proposals. We are completing Bargaining Training and attending Fraser Valley Coordinated Bargaining monthly meetings.

School District employees are unique in that we bargain at both the Provincial level (“big ticket” items such as wages and benefits) AND at the Local level (items such as Leaves, Vacation, Job Security, etc)

Your Negotiating Committee is made up of one representative from each of our five (5) divisions. The Union President, or their designate, is also part of the Local’s Bargaining team.
