June 30th 2019 brings an end to our existing Collective Agreement with the Chilliwack School District. The CUPE 411 Negotiating Committee has dates scheduled to begin bargaining conversations with our Employer.

With Provincial bargaining already completed, your CUPE 411 Negotiating Committee is currently at the table with the Employer. Bargaining Protocols have been agreed too and Proposals have been exchanged. Future dates are planned to continue local bargaining.

School District employees are unique in that we bargain at both the Provincial level (“big ticket” items such as wages and benefits) AND at the Local level (items such as Leaves, Vacation, Job Security, etc)

Your Negotiating Committee is made up of one representative from each of our five (5) divisions. The Union President, or their designate, is also part of the Local’s Bargaining team. The chief spokesperson for our Local is our CUPE National Servicing Representative, as they too are at the table.
