Increased GST for low-income individuals	One-time payment of increased GST	One-time special payment by early May 2020 through the Goods and Services Tax credit (GSTC). This will double the maximum annual GSTC payment amounts for the 2019-20 benefit year. The average boost to income for those benefitting from this measure will be close to \$400 for single individuals and close to \$600 for couples	Application is not required for this payment. If eligible, it will be received automatically
Employment Insurance	Improved access to Employment Insurance (EI)	1 week waiting period is waived	Apply online at El
Emergency Response Benefit (for those not eligible for EI)	For those not covered under El and those unable to work for COVID-19 related reasons, up to \$2000/month for 4 months	The Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) would be paid every 4 weeks and be available from March 15, 2020 until October 3, 2020. Applicants would begin to receive CERB payments	Apply via website which will be available April 6, 2020 Applicants can also apply via an automated telephone line or a toll-free number
