You can expect to attend anywhere from two (2) to four (4) meetings the duration of which will be determined by the knowledge and scope of understanding of those at the table. Depending on the time and duration of the meetings the Union will provide light refreshments or even a meal(s). All meetings will take place at the Union Office (see below).
